2.	<p>Presentation on TANF Opportunity Pilot & East TN Collaborative: Kaki Reynolds</p> <p>DHS grant—one of 7 grantees across state, but only one locally to help spend down extra TANF funds. Goal is for families to reach self-sufficiency. “Economic Mobility Pathways” model—mobility mentors housed in 5 partner organizations to work with families on dreams/goals for their future. Flyers available; accepting referrals currently. Workforce placement program through Urban League is also a part of this. Ideal candidates: US citizens, custody of children in home, receiving some type of gov’t assistance, interest in self-sufficiency journey.</p>

Planning</u>—Advance Knox, comprehensive plan underway in county—draft will be made for public review in a few months for public input (advanceknox.org)</p> <p><u>American Heart Association</u>—collaboration with Second Harvest to support food pantries that lack cold storage/shelving units (promoting produce and heart-healthy foods); hoping to launch utensil drive for Western Heights (welcome baskets for new residents in new/upgraded units)</p> <p><u>KCDC</u>—next Wednesday is kickoff for non-profit partners, 9 AM at Emerald Youth Foundation (revitalizing housing but also entire Beaumont neighborhood—one building is dedicated to food access and food entrepreneurship to create vitality in the community); website will be launched soon</p> <p><u>KCHD</u>—job announcement-RD in community health, primary focus on chronic disease (masters degree preferred); job posted until 3/30 on county HR website</p>

	<p><u>United Way</u>—conducting community-wide food security assessment; creating network map of organizations in food system—instructions to be included on map will be provided with minutes (list partners and/or potential partners); organizations can also list what they do within the food system</p>
